PAVING

RHGID has enlisted the services of A&K Earthmovers to complete our 2013 paving project. A&K will be paving Elks Point Road from the intersection with McFaul Way to the end of Elks Point Rd. Construction is expected to begin in mid-June. Round Hill residents can expect traffic delays as construction activities proceed. Work consists of grinding the existing roadway and re-use of the grindings to act as a new base for the roadway and paving over the top of the newly constructed road base. Upon completion of the work on Elks Point Road, McFaul Way will be seal coated to help protect the new paving that was constructed in 2010. This year's project is the second phase of a twenty year plan to maintain the District's roadways. Phase three is scheduled for 2016.

PINE NEEDLE PICK UP

Pine Needle Pick Up for this year is scheduled to occur on Monday and Tuesday, June 3rd and 4th, 2013. After Wednesday, May 29th, your regular trash pickup day, you may set your bags of clean pine needles and cones curbside in a pile for pickup. If you miss these dates, clean pine needles, cones and slash can be taken to Boulder parking lot on South Benjamin Drive as part of the Tahoe Douglas Fire District's "Compost Your Combustibles" program from May 25th through July 7, 2013.

Funds are available again this summer for assistance with removing fuels for defensible space. Contact John Pickett at the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District at 775-588-3591. You will need a Defensible Space Evaluation prior to beginning work. After the work is done, contact John for 50% reimbursement.
